Internship Program Admissions

The Albizu Clinic Internship is an exclusively affiliated internship for doctoral students from Albizu University's APA-accredited Psy.D. and Ph.D. programs in Clinical Psychology. Albizu Clinic is an outpatient community mental health treatment facility affiliated with Albizu University's San Juan Campus. The internship is a full-time, 12-month training experience offering three tracks: the General Clinical Program, Domestic Violence Program, and Sexual Abuse Program. Interns across all three tracks provide psychotherapy and psychological assessment services. In addition, interns work collaboratively with senior supervisors and provide weekly supervision to first-year graduate students under the oversight of a licensed supervisor, allowing interns to further develop competency in supervision. Applicants should review the [Albizu Clinic Internship Program Handbook](#) for detailed information regarding eligibility, selection criteria, practicum and academic preparation requirements, and other program requirements.
