The Bachelor of Science in Psychology is offered on campus and 100% online. The BS program at Albizu University's Miami Campus offers a solid foundation in mental health and essential skills for graduate studies.

This program offers a minor in Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), with courses verified by the Association for Behavior Analysis International (ABAI). This verification allows students to meet the requirements for the Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) examination and enables those who complete the Verified Course Sequence (VCS) to bypass additional documentation during application.

Students can also pursue a minor in Speech-Language Pathology (SLP), requiring nine elective courses (24 credits) and at least 100 clinical practicum hours. This minor prepares students for careers as Speech-Language Pathology Assistants and fulfills the certification requirements of the Florida Board of Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology and the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA).
