

Dr. Carlos Albizu established the university in 1966 with a theory of education premised on his philosophy that "knowledge that is based solely on logic and reason may become dehumanizing and is not at the service of humanity. Education that is guided by love emphasizes social welfare more than it does individual competition". Founded in 1966, Albizu University (AU) is the first professional school of psychology established in the United States and the Caribbean.

EXCELLENCE

The university is accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education; the American Psychological Association accredits its clinical psychology programs; and the Master of Science program in Speech-Language Pathology is accredited by the Council on Academic Accreditation (CAA) of the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA).

Our programs are designed for students from all cultural and ethnic backgrounds, offering rich exposure to culturally diverse populations through academic training and applied experiences. 

PSYCHOLOGY SERVICES



Individual Therapy

Individualized therapy sessions for children, adolescents, and adults. We help manage any situation that causes emotional distress to improve quality of life.



Group Therapy

The aim is to expand individuals' support networks to help them address their problems collectively.



Couples Therapy

We address emotional issues and conflicts that are affecting the couple.



Family Therapy

The goal is to address the needs of each family member and work together to find solutions that reduce tensions and improve interactions with one another.



Evaluations

We offer psychometric, psychoeducational, psychological, and neurological assessments. Additionally, evaluations for the diagnosis of autism in children and adults are conducted.
