<p>Selection of potential applicants into the Goodman Psychological Services Center Psychology Doctoral Internship Program is based on various factors to determine best fit. The internship program is clinically focused, therefore, we seek applicants who show a breadth and depth of training experiences in evidenced based treatments with diverse clients. Experienced with various modality of treatments are preferred which include individual, couples, family, and group therapy. The internship also considers applicants who demonstrate a strong background in psychological assessments, preferably psycho-educational testing. Additionally, applicants should demonstrate critical thinking abilities, self-reflectiveness and insight, and good interpersonal skills. Although bilingual candidates (English and Spanish fluency) is preferable, it is not required. The internship program considers all graduate students from APA-accredited Psy.D. or Ph.D. programs who have successfully completed all the necessary academic and supervised clinical practicum training to be considered eligible for internship by the doctoral program's respective Director of Clinical Training (DCT).</p>
